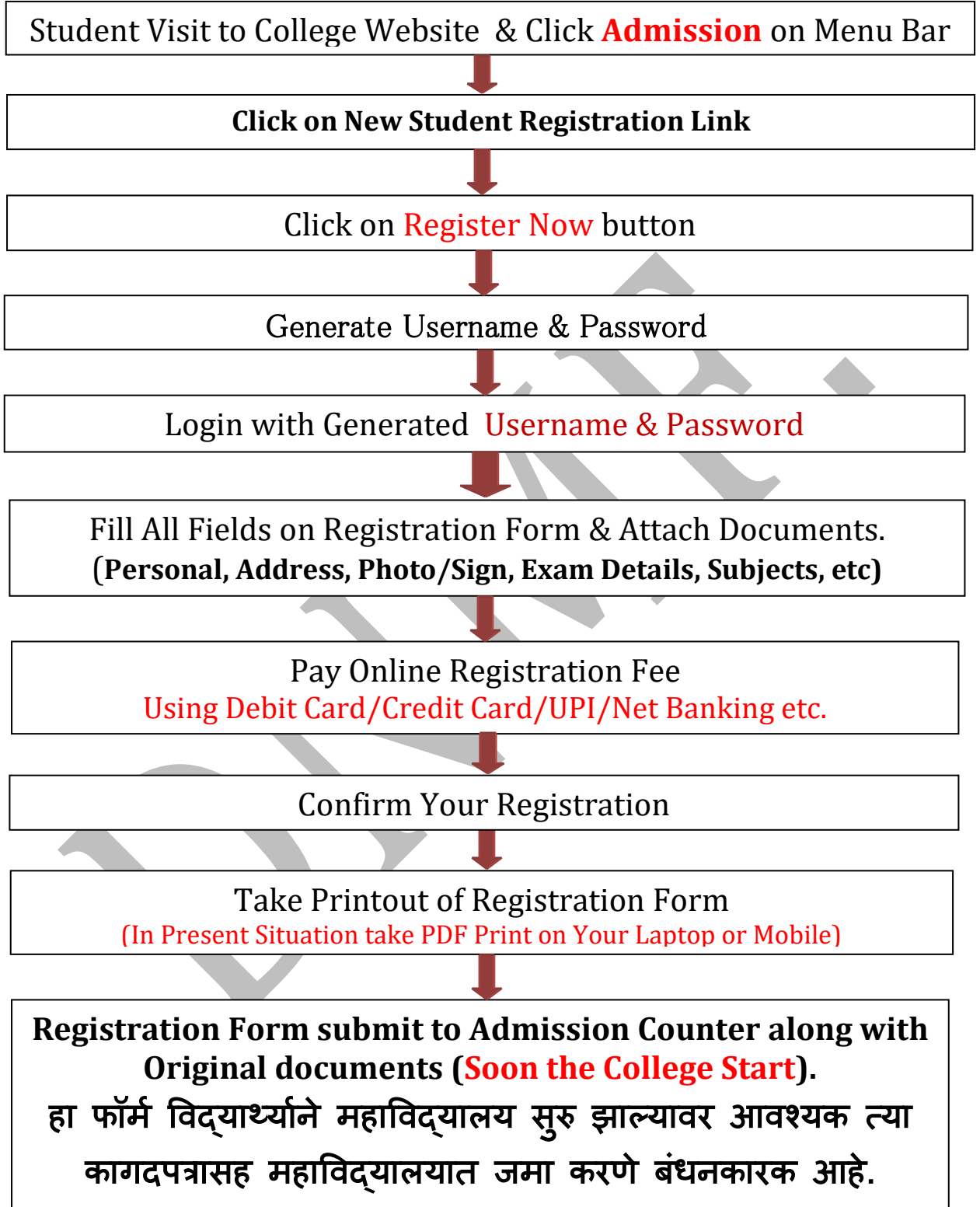

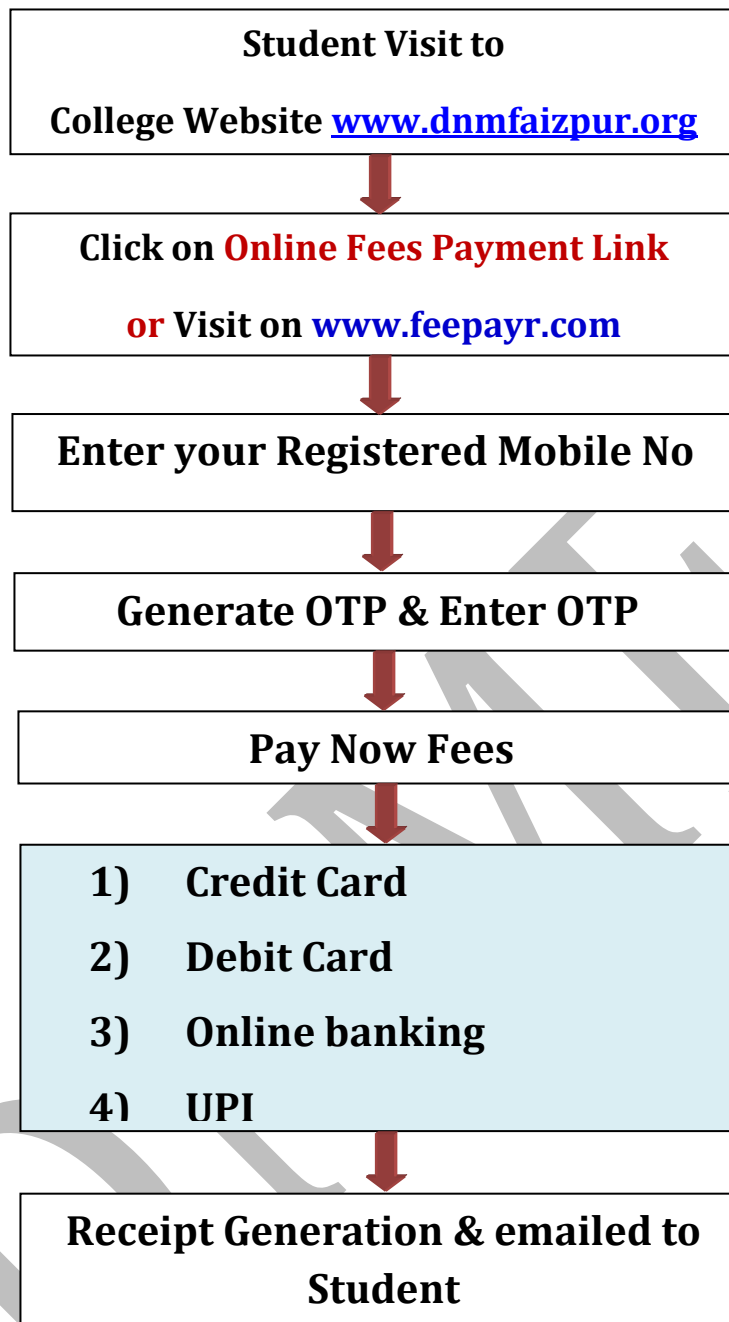

Time to Time change in Fees will be mandatory for the student.

Eligibility Criteria:

Only eligible candidate is admitted to the respective Class/Course according to the eligibility conditions laid down by North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.

1. Bachelor of Arts (BA) :

- a) Candidate must have passed 10+2 H.S.C. Exam of Maharashtra State or its Equivalent examination of any other statutory board or University with the support English in any system.
- b) D.Ed. Course with English after Xth Std.
- c) Diploma in Engineering Course from MSBTE.
- d) The candidates who have passed any Professional Degree or Diploma Course is eligible for F.Y.B.A.
- e) The candidate who are graduates form the faculties other than Arts, Mental, Moral and Social Sciences (Without Professional Courses) are allowed to keep terms for S.Y.B.A. Course without appearing or keeping terms for F.Y.B.A. Course.
- f) HSC Vocational (MCVC) Course: Candidate have passed (10+2) H.S.C. MCVC examination may be considered eligible for admission to F. Y. B. A.

2. Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.):

- a) Candidate must have passed 10+2 H.S.C. Exam. of Maharashtra State or its equivalent examination of any other statutory board or University with the subject English and any three Science subjects out of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Geography and Geology shall be eligible for F.Y.B.Sc. (Also eligible Candidate who passed Urdu medium but criteria is same above.)
- b) Diploma in Engineering and Pharmacy from MSBTE or its equivalent.
- c) A candidate must have passed 10+2 examination with English form Science stream and D.Ed. Course.

- d) A candidate who has passed any Professional Degree or Diploma Course and passed XIIth Std. from Science stream is eligible for F. Y. B. Sc.
- e) For F. Y. B. Sc. Computer, a candidate must have passed (10+2) H.S.C. Science exam from Maharashtra State Secondary and Higher Secondary Board or its equivalent with English, Maths and Physics.
- f) HSC Vocational (MCVC) Course: Candidate passed (10+2) H.S.C. MCVC examination may be considered eligible for admission to F. Y. B. Sc. and have a choice of subjects Physics, Electronics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.
- g) Diploma in Engineering from Maharashtra Technical Board or its equivalent is eligible for S. Y. B. Sc. However, it may please be noted that the said student could not take subject of B- Group.
- 3. Bachelor of Commerce (B. Com.):**
- a) Candidate must have passed 10+2 H.S.C. Exam. of Maharashtra State or its equivalent examination of any other statutory board or University. or
- b) (10+2) H.S.C. Examination form Maharashtra State Board or its equivalent with D.Ed. or
- c) Diploma in Engineering and Pharmacy form MSBTE or its equivalent.
- d) HSC Vocational (MCVC) Course: Candidate have passed (10+2) H.S.C. MCVC examination may be considered eligible for admission to F. Y. B. Com.
- 4. M. A. (Except M. A. Geography):**
Candidate must have passed Three year Degree course from any faculty form any statutory University shall be eligible.
- 5. M. Sc. :**
Candidate must have passed Three Years Bachelor's Degree Examination in Science Faculty from a recognized statutory university with subjects studied at FY/SY/TY level. The admission process is centralized and conducted by NMU.
- 6. M. Com. :**
Candidate must have passed Three years Bachelor's Degree Examination in Commerce and Management faculty from a recognized university.
- 7. Admission Regarding External Student's:**
The candidate registered by other Universities/Boards as an External/Private student shall not be allowed to join college for next subsequent higher class/semester.
The students who have passed 12th std. examination of Maharashtra State Board, by filling Form No. 17 are eligible for admission to any course. However, eligibility criteria will be same as mentioned above.
The students who have passed the F.Y/S.Y. examination in any faculty as external / private student are not eligible for any higher class admission.

Admission Procedure

- 1) **The student seeking admission at First Year (UG & PG) have to register online on college admission software. The online link is available on college website - www.dnmfaizpur.org in admission link. This registration is compulsory.**
- 2) For admission to First Year Classes (UG and PG) eligibility form, original mark sheet of qualifying examination, Leaving Certificate / Transfer Certificate, Migration Certificate (for change of Board / University / State) are necessary.
- 3) Admission will not be confirmed unless eligibility is approved by NMU.
- 4) For admission to SY and TY Classes attested photocopy of mark sheet of the previous examinations is necessary.
- 5) The students seeking admission to SY and TY classes form other colleges within jurisdiction of NMU must produce Transfer Certificate, College change Form, Online Transfer Certificate from previous college. Besides this, attested photocopy of mark sheet of the previous examination is necessary.
- 6) For Readmission: Prescribed readmission form, Transfer Certificate, Original Mark sheet of the previous examination, Online Transfer Certificate (for college change only), Gap Certificate if any are necessary.
- 7) For change of faculty: Prescribed readmission form, Change of Faculty form, Transfer Certificate, Original Mark sheet of the previous examination, Online Transfer Certificate (for college change only), Gap Certificate if any are necessary.
- 8) After admission the students can be allowed to change the offered subject / faculty by the authorities only on payment of Rs. 100/-. The last date for such change will be notified on the notice board.

Certificates Required Along with Admission and Eligibility Form:

- Every student seeking admission to any Graduate or Post Graduate Course of North Maharashtra University for the First Time is required to obtain eligibility from university. Student has to apply in prescribed form and pay the required amount of fee.
- Student who passed out 10+2 Higher Secondary Examination form Maharashtra State, is required to submit following certificates in original along with two attested photocopy of each:
 1. LC/TC/ (LC/TC will be kept to colleges)
 2. Statement of Marks of qualifying examinations.
 3. Cast Certificate for student who belongs to SC/ST/VJNT/OBC/SBC.
 4. Aadhaar Card Photocopy.
 5. Latest Gap Certificate (if applicable)
 6. Copy of admission letter issued by Admission Authority in case of Centralized Admission Process by the NMU (For M. Sc. only).
 7. Passing Certificate (For M.Sc. Only).
- Students migrating from the jurisdiction of another University / Board, the following certificates in original along with attested photocopy of each shall be attached to the application form along with the above certificates:
 1. Migration Certificate.
 2. Passing Certificate (For M. Sc. only).
 3. Attendance Certificate.

Facilities

Teaching Staff : The College has efficient, well experienced and highly qualified teachers. About 15 teachers are holding M. Phil. degree, 33 are holding Ph.D. degree and 15 NET/SET qualified.

Library: The College has a beautiful and spacious library building. Library has a massive collection of more than 61500 books and it subscribes to 78 periodicals and journals every year. Specifically library includes books, text books and reference books recommended by the Board of Studies of the University and UGC. The reading room in the library has the capacity to accommodate 100 students at a time and is kept from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

- Student is admitted to the Library as well as in the reading room only on presentation of identity Card had has to observe complete silence and abide by the rules of conduct framed form time to time in this regard.
- A special issue counter is provided for issuing the books for home reading. Book can be issued for the period of maximum seven days. Class wise specific days are fixed for issuing the books. Students have to fill in the demand slip on the previous day. Programme of issuing book for home reading is displayed on the notice board. Student can borrow only one book at a time.
- Book in reading room can be issued only for using the book in the reading room. It is mandatory for the students to take no dues certificate from the Librarian before 15th March. These after prior permission from the Principal will be required.
- Intimation of the loss of book should be given to the Librarian within two days. In such cases Five times the cost of the lost book will be recovered from the student.
- Before leaving the issuing counter, make sure that the book borrowed is in good and neat condition, thereafter no complaint will be considered by the Librarian.
- If identity Card in lost, immediately inform to the Librarian. Library will not be responsible for the misuse of identity Card.

Hostel: The college has well equipped ladies hostels. The hostel building is situated in the college campus. Accommodation for 150 girls is available in the ladies hostel. Hostel admission is given on merit basis. Repeaters are not admitted in hostel. Few seats are reserved for students belonging to scheduled caste and scheduled tribes. For other details student may refer to the separate prospectus for hostel, which is made available in the Grahak Sahakari Bhandar established on the college campus.

Gymkhana : The college has large playing fields about 6 acres, which fulfils the needs of all outdoor sport event. Facilities for indoor games are also provided. The enthusiastic and sporty environment has

developed wonderful sports personal in various games and sports tradition. Boys and Girls are availed with various sports facilities enlisted below. Sports Infrastructures : (Total Area- 6 Acres)
Large sport ground for cricket, hockey, athletics and Indian games, Table Tennis Hall, Badminton Hall, Hand-ball court, Equipped Gym., Boxing Hall etc. is available.

National Services Scheme (N. S. S.) : N. S. S. programme is run by the college. Every year 220 students are registered. Students are expected to dedicate 120 hours for social work and attend the camp organized in the schedule of the year. Certificates are awarded to students who satisfactorily comply the attendance norms.

National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.) : The unit of National Cadet Corps of the college has 53 enrollment capacity which comes under the administration of 18 MAH Bn. NCC., Jalgaon. It focuses on the military training to the students for avail the opportunities entering into Arm Forces. Its chief motto is to imbibe the values of discipline and unity among the students. Through NCC activity the students have the benefits of a number of adventurous activities along with camps such as Annual Training Camp, National Integration Camp, Trekking Camp, Mountaineering Camp, Thal Sainik Camp, Republic Day Camp etc. The students can get benefits of a number of scholarship, CWS Scholarship, Sahara Scholarship etc. NCC has an unique opportunity to develop multidimensional personality and make a bright career in various fields such as Indian Army, Mumbai Police, CRPF, BSF, ITBP etc. In addition to this, the students can get grace marks under Ordinance 163 after successful completion of two years of NCC and qualifying "B" or "C" certificate exam.

A student with Arts background may have the option to pursue a course in Food Technology and Dairy Science. Similarly a student with Commerce background may have the option to pursue in Certificate Course in Web Designing.
