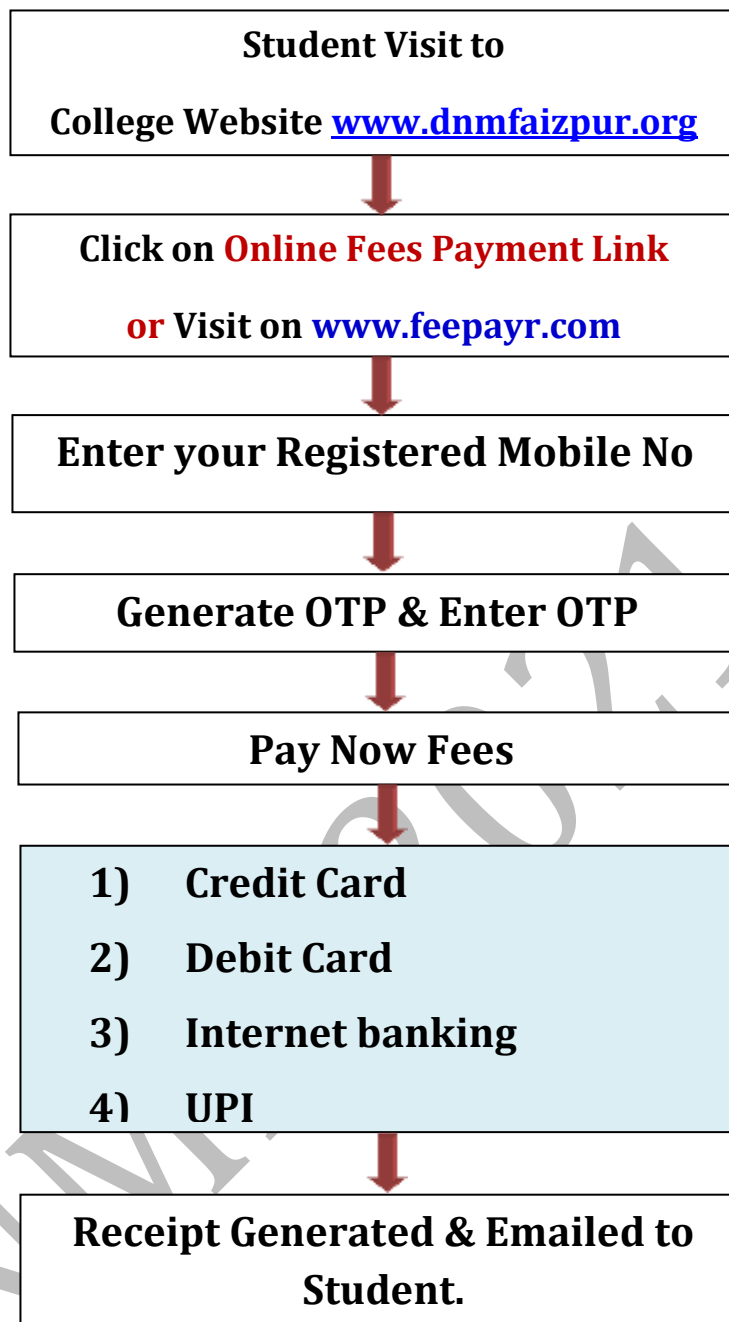

VOCATIONAL COURSES OFFERED:

Bachelor of Vocational (B. Voc)

Vocational or skill-based education is becoming more and more significant with passing time. BVoc (Bachelor of Vocation) is an emerging course that aims at providing adequate skills required for a particular trade to candidates. The course is different from traditional academic programmes as it deals more with application-based studies rather than focusing on only theoretical knowledge.

The three-year duration undergraduate vocational courses (B Voc) available with us are;

- 1) Chemistry in Industry & Analytical Techniques
- 2) Green House Management
- 3) E-Accounting and E-Taxation

One of the biggest advantages of pursuing BVoc against common degree courses is that a candidate has multiple exit points during the programme and continued industry exposure. This means that if a candidate is unable to complete his/ her BVoc course, s/he has is still awarded a diploma after successful completion of first year or advanced diploma after successful completion of second year.

Eligibility Criteria:

Only eligible candidate is admitted to the respective Class/Course according to the eligibility conditions laid down by North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.

Facilities

Library: The College has a beautiful and spacious library building. Library has a massive collection of more than 61500 books and it subscribes to 78 periodicals and journals every year. Specifically library includes books, text books and reference books recommended by the Board of Studies of the University and UGC. The reading room in the library has the capacity to accommodate 100 students at a time and is kept from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

- Student is admitted to the Library as well as in the reading room only on presentation of identity Card had has to observe complete silence and abide by the rules of conduct framed from time to time in this regard.
- A special issue counter is provided for issuing the books for home reading. Book can be issued for the period of maximum seven days. Class wise specific days are fixed for issuing the books. Students have to fill in the demand slip on the previous day. Programme of issuing book for home reading is displayed on the notice board. Student can borrow only one book at a time.
- Book in reading room can be issued only for using the book in the reading room. It is mandatory for the students to take no dues certificate from the Librarian before 15th March. These after prior permission from the Principal will be required.
- Intimation of the loss of book should be given to the Librarian within two days. In such cases Five times the cost of the lost book will be recovered from the student.
- Before leaving the issuing counter, make sure that the book borrowed is in good and neat condition, thereafter no complaint will be considered by the Librarian.
- If identity Card is lost, immediately inform to the Librarian. Library will not be responsible for the misuse of identity Card.

Hostel: The college has well equipped ladies hostels. The hostel building is situated in the college campus. Accommodation for 150 girls is available in the ladies hostel. Hostel admission is given on merit basis. Repeaters are not admitted in hostel. Few seats are reserved for students belonging to scheduled caste and scheduled tribes.
